**Change 1 to the NOR, relating to J Class Yachts only.**

2. Rules, add the following:

2. f) For J Class Yachts a series of races on a separate course area will be run by the J Class association and the following rules apply:

- I. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 - 2020* (RRS).
- II. World Sailing RRS Addendum Q Umpired Fleet Racing.
- III. In addition to the penalties described in the Addendum Q, the Jury may impose suitable penalties, other than disqualification, for violations of the class rules or other non-Part 2 rules. This changes RRS 64.1.
- IV. The J Class Association Class Rule will apply.
- V. No National authority prescriptions will apply.

4. Eligibility and Entry, add the following:

- 4.1.1 The event is open to J Class yachts with a valid J Class certificate.
- 4.1.2 The boat's owner shall be a member of the J Class Association.

For J Class Yachts Delete 4.5 a) and b) and replace with the following

- d) a completed crew declaration form.
- e) a valid J Class Association certificate.
